**Enrollment in and payment of your deposit for the tour, constitutes your acceptance of the conditions and statement of responsibility.**

**INCLUDED IN PRICE:** 1) Deluxe motor coaches, First Class / Superior First Class hotels, guided sightseeing, entrance fees to sites visited, breakfast & dinner daily at hotel; 2) Gratuities of \$280 CAD (\$218.40 USD) for tour guide, driver, and local services; 3) Egypt entry visa \$25 CAD (\$19.50 USD); 4) \$17 CAD (\$13.26 USD) departure taxes from Egypt to Israel; 5) flight from Cairo to Sharm El Sheikh.

**NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:** Not included in your package are passports, visas, vaccinations, laundry, lunches, telephone, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, and food outside of the contracted tour operator menu as presented at a hotel or restaurant (these extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, or restaurant), airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portage at airports, travel insurance, excess baggage fees, any fees or fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines after the date you register for your trip, and all other items not specifically mentioned.

**PAYMENT:** A full deposit of \$500 USD per person is required at time of registration. Final payment must be made in the form of a check (credit cards are only accepted for initial deposit, any remaining payments must be in check form) and is due no later than **90-days prior to departure**. Registrations received after 90-days prior to departure **must be accompanied by full payment**. **There may be a late fee of \$195 USD for all payments or new registrations received 75-60 days prior to departure**. All tour prices are based on a minimum group size of 40 passengers for prices to be valid. If group size is 30-21 travelers, a \$318 CAD (\$248.04 USD) per person supplement to price may apply. If group size is less than 20 travelers, the tour may be cancelled due to lack of participation. **If final (full) payment is not received by Imagine Tours and Travel, LLC/Faith Beyond Belief (hereafter referred to as Imagine/FBB) 60-days prior to departure, you will be automatically cancelled from the tour and your initial deposit of \$500 USD will be forfeited.** Imagine reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2.5% against the Canadian Dollar based on foreign exchange rates in effect on 04/05/18 (Pricing based on exchange of the Canadian Dollar to US Dollar on this date at conversion of 0.78 exchange). **All payments are required in US Funds.**

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Price is based on double occupancy (two persons sharing a room). When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. If one is not available or if you request a single room, there will be a **single room supplement charge: \$1170 CAD (\$912.60 USD) for basic itinerary.**

You will be notified in writing when possible. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$195 USD per night/per person (single rooms \$225 USD/night). Meals for extra nights are not included. Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed by the passenger must be provided in writing to Imagine/FBB no later than 75-days prior to departure and any extra costs incurred will be billed to the passenger. All deviations are subject to a standard fee of \$150 USD plus any applicable airline fees. **All tours are final at 60-days prior to departure. 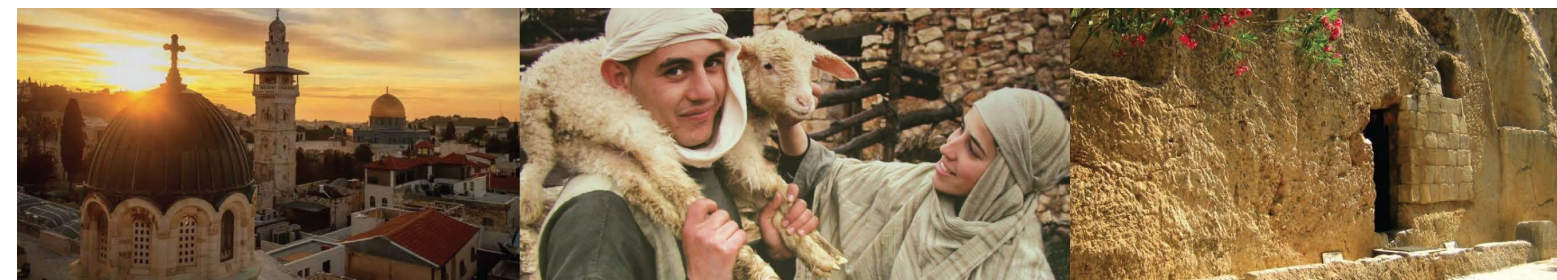

OCTOBER 17 – NOVEMBER 1, 2019

Itinerary subject to change during the journey, depending on weather, traffic, scheduling and other circumstances. Leadership and guides will consult together to determine the best plan for the group's benefit.

#### DAY 1 – THURSDAY, OCTOBER 17: DEPART CANADA FOR CAIRO

Today we depart from Canada on our flight(s) to Cairo. Group seating will be pre-assigned by the airline for our flight. Dinner and complimentary in-flight service will be provided this evening. (D)

#### DAY 2 – FRIDAY, OCTOBER 18: ARRIVE CAIRO

At Cairo Airport, we are met by our Tour Manager who will assist us with immigration and luggage formalities. From the airport, we take the short drive to our hotel where we can unpack and relax. Tonight, we will have our 'welcome dinner' in anticipation of a memorable journey. (B, D)

#### DAY 3 – SATURDAY, OCTOBER 19: CAIRO HIGHLIGHTS

This morning we will have our first breakfast before our day of sightseeing, which will include:

**Pyramids of Giza** – Truly magnificent! Not only can you stand on these great testaments to ancient engineering but, optionally, you can walk through the passageways of the Great Pyramid to its inner core, the Great Chamber.

**Great Sphinx** – To this day, there is much debate over who built this large monument and to whom it was dedicated. Regardless, the Great Sphinx has stood the test of time and is a wonder to see.

**Egypt Museum** – Host to over 120,000 artifacts, there is much to see, including the famous Tutankhamun collection.

**Felucca Ride** – An enjoyable ride on the river Nile, onboard the small Felucca sail boats, before returning to our hotel.

Back at our hotel, we will enjoy dinner and relaxation. (B, D)

#### DAY 4 – SUNDAY, OCTOBER 20: COPTIC CAIRO, CAVE CHURCH, SHARM EL SHEIK, RED SEA

**Coptic Cairo** – The Hanging church and early Christianity. Traditional location of where Mary, Joseph and Jesus stayed during their time in Egypt. See how the place of hiding became a place of refuge.

**Cave Church** – Enter the largest church in this part of the world! Seating 17,000 people, this church was dug out of the rock by the community that lives around it: the "outcast" Christian garbage collectors and recyclers of Cairo! Hear the story, sing a hymn to God's Amazing Grace!

**Sharm El Sheik** – After an evening flight from Cairo over the desert to Sharm El Sheik, we enter the waterfront luxury playground of Egypt, where we enjoy the sand and scenery. Overnight is in Sharm. (B, D)

#### DAY 5 – MONDAY, OCTOBER 21: RED SEA, WELL OF MARAH, MT. SINAI

**Red Sea** – Our day begins where Moses and the Israelites embarked on their Exodus Journey: at the Red Sea. Enjoy the beautiful surroundings even more when you remember that this place was a gateway of promise.

**Well of Marah** – We drive towards the Promised Land, stopping at the Well of Marah where God turned bitter water sweet for Moses and the people to drink.

**Mount Sinai** – Continuing across the Sinai desert, we arrive at the foot of Mt. Sinai by late afternoon.

Here we find St. Catherine's Monastery, built on the traditional site of Moses' encounter with the Burning Bush.

Overnight is in the Monastery's guest house. We may walk among its peaceful, rocky surroundings. (B, D)

#### DAY 6 – TUESDAY, OCTOBER 22: MT. SINAI SUMMIT FOR SUNRISE, OVERNIGHT IN TABA

**Mt. Sinai**—Those of you who wish, can ascend Mt. Sinai for sunrise. A truly unique and spectacular moment! Those less energetic may tour the monastery grounds and surrounding area. Maybe catch a camel picture!

**Taba** - This afternoon, we leave for the Red Sea where we will stay for one night and enjoy the surroundings. Dinner and overnight will be at our hotel by the Red Sea. (B, D)

#### DAY 7 – WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 23: ENTER ISRAEL

This morning we cross into Israel and begin our journey in the land of "milk and honey."

**Timna Valley** – This unique area of geological formations is rich in copper. Experts believe that this is the area where Solomon mined for copper. Whilst here, we shall visit the Tabernacle Model. This full-scale reproduction is accurate in every way to the dimensions described in the Bible.

**Masada** – This UNESCO World Heritage site was once Herod's mountain top palace and fortress. Here we ascend to the site by cable car and learn about the last Jewish stand against the Romans and the mass suicide of the 960 Jewish defenders.

**Dead Sea** – No visit to the Dead Sea would be complete without experiencing the unique buoyancy of these waters. Float your aches and pains away!

Today our final resting place is our hotel, located on the shores of the Dead Sea. Dinner will be at our hotel. (B, D)

#### DAY 8 – THURSDAY, OCTOBER 24: EIN GEDI, QUMRAN, DRIVE BY GILGAL, BEIT SHEAN, TIBERIUS

We stay in the Judean wilderness and follow the shores of The Dead Sea to visit:

**Ein Gedi** – This national park and oasis hosts the caves of David's Gorge where David hid from Saul and his army. (I Samuel 24, Song of Solomon 1:14; Ezekiel 47:10)

**Qumran** – Home to the ancient Essenes. It is here that they wrote the Dead Sea Scrolls almost two thousand years ago. Here we will visit the excavated sites of Qumran and view the location where The Scrolls were found in 1947.

**Gilgal** - After Qumran, we head further north and pass Gilgal, where Saul was proclaimed king. Gilgal became a sacred place because the tribes of Israel first encamped and celebrated Passover there after their miraculous crossing of the Jordan River and before their conquest of the Promised Land.

**Harod's Spring** – Here, Gideon gathered his men before fighting the Midianites. (Judges 7:1-8)

**Beit She'an** – The largest of Israel's archeological digs. Even after the initial discovery many years ago, archeologists are still discovering more ruins from the Roman era (time of Jesus) when Beit She'an was one of the 10 cities in The Decapolis.

This ancient city, although destroyed by an earthquake in the 8th Century, offers a fabulous insight into Roman life and times.

Long before that time, after losing their last battle to the Philistines, King Saul and his sons were hung from the city walls (Judges 4:7-8).

We continue up into the region of Galilee. Settle into a comfortable Kibbutz in Tiberius for the next 3 nights. (B, D)

#### DAY 9 – FRIDAY, OCTOBER 25: HAZOR, TEL DAN, CAESAREA PHILIPPI

After breakfast, we spend our day in the upper Galilee. Driving northward our day includes:

**Hazor** – Once the largest city in all of Canaan. The multi-layered Tel of Hazor offers intrigue and insight into 5000 years of civilization. Here Deborah and Barak fought against Sisera. Captured by Joshua and razed to the ground, this city was rebuilt by Solomon in the 10th century BC (Joshua 11:10-14; Judges 4:2; I Kings 9:15).

**Tel Dan** – This national park and archeological site offer a blend of Israel's natural beauty and Biblical history!

**Caesarea Philippi** – Built at one of the sources of the Jordan River, the city of Pnias (named by the Greeks after the goat-footed god, Pan) was later renamed by the Romans as Caesarea Philippi. It was here that Jesus revealed to the Disciples His purpose - the Church. Here Peter identified Jesus as the Messiah (Mark 8:27; Matthew 16:13-23).

Dinner and overnight will be at our kibbutz. (B, D)

#### DAY 10 – SATURDAY, OCTOBER 26: CANA, NAZARETH, MOUNT OF BEATITUDES, CAPERNAUM, BETHSAIDA, TABGHA.

**Cana** – Now a suburb of Nazareth, Cana, is where Jesus performed his first miracle, changing water into wine at a wedding. (Luke 1:26-38; John 1:46; Matthew 2:23)

**Nazareth** – Here Jesus spent his childhood with Mary and Joseph. Nazareth is also the site of The Annunciation and where the Nazarenes attempted to throw Jesus over the cliff.

**The Mount of Beatitudes** – Sit on the hill where Jesus delivered his Sermon on the Mount. Here, by the Sea of Galilee, the flower filled gardens offer peace and tranquility. (Matthew 5:1-8).

**Capernaum** – The center of Jesus' Galilee Ministry. Jesus lived here for a substantial period, healing the sick, preaching in the synagogue and performing miracles. (Matthew 9:1; 4:13)

**Bethsaida** – Also known as 'The House of The Fisherman', this is the home of Peter, Philip and Andrew, and also the place where Jesus fed the five thousand and healed the blind man. Here, we will see recent excavations of this old city. (Matthew 11:21; Luke 10:13; John 1:35-42)

**Church of the Primacy of Peter** - The shore where Jesus met Peter after the Resurrection. (John 21)

**Tabgha** – Located at the foot of the Mt. of Beatitudes this is the site of the Miracle of The Loaves and the Fishes. (Mark 6:34-44; Matthew 14:14-21; 16:18-19; John 21:15-19) Our final overnight will be at our kibbutz. (B, D)

#### DAY 11 – SUNDAY, OCTOBER 27: SEA OF GALILEE BOAT RIDE, MEGIDDO, MT. CARMEL, CAESAREA, JERUSALEM

**Sea of Galilee Boat Ride** – Today starts with a boat ride on the shining Sea of Galilee.

**Megiddo** – Hebrew for Armageddon, Megiddo was strategically located on the main trading routes between Babylonia and Egypt. Here King Solomon built a giant fortress and city. (Judges 1:27; 5:19; 1 Kings 4:12; 9:15, II Chronicles 35:22; Zechariah 12:12, Revelation 16:16)

**Mount Carmel** – Overlooking the city of Haifa with the Mediterranean Sea and Jezreel Valley on either side we stand where the Prophet Elijah performed his miracle and called upon the fire of God to conquer the Prophets of Baal. (1 Kings 2; 15:4,25, Isaiah 33:9; Zechariah 12:12)

**Caesarea** – The ancient Roman seaport capital of Israel where Pontius Pilate had his base.

After another fascinating day, we shall travel 'up' to Jerusalem, the final resting place of our journey. (B, D)

#### DAY 12 – MONDAY, OCTOBER 28: JERUSALEM

After breakfast, we retrace steps of the Lord Jesus.

**Mount of Olives** – We begin our day by viewing Jerusalem from the Mt. of Olives. Photo opportunities abound, with the Golden Dome of the Rock prominent above the white city walls. From here we shall walk down to The Garden of Gethsemane along the same path as Jesus took when entering the city on Palm Sunday.

**Garden of Gethsemane** – The site where Jesus prayed at the Rock of Agony in the Garden. - (Matthew 26:36-56; Mark 14:32-50; Luke 22:39-53; John 18:1-14)

**House of Caiaphas** – Located under the current St. Peter of Gallicantu church is the traditional site where Jesus was imprisoned

**Upper Room** – The traditional site where Jesus instituted a new Passover celebration and the new Covenant in His blood. (Mark 14:15)

**Church of St. Anne** – Near the pools of Bethesda where Jesus healed the cripple. (John 5:1-9)

**Via Dolorosa** – Walk part of the one-mile-long route through the Old City of Jerusalem, from the point of condemnation by Pontius Pilate to Golgotha, Calvary Hill.

**Holy Sepulchre Church** – built over the Mount of Crucifixion – Golgotha, and the Tomb of Jesus.

Dinner is served at our hotel this evening. (B, D)

#### DAY 13 – TUESDAY, OCTOBER 29: JERUSALEM

**Shrine of the Book museum** – Here, we can see many original fragments of the Dead Sea scrolls plus a replica of the great Isaiah scroll.

**Scale Model of Jerusalem** – This fabulous reconstruction of the old city of Jerusalem gives us a chance to understand the importance of the second temple and city during Herodian times.

**Israel Museum** – The newly renovated museum is home to many historical artifacts that resonate with the Bible.

**Yad Vashem** – The national museum and memorial to the holocaust.

We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

#### DAY 14 – WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 30: JERUSALEM

**Temple Mount** – Pending access to the site, we will see al-Aqsa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock.

**Western Wall** – The remaining foundational wall of Herod's temple, where people come to pray.

**Davidson Centre** – This new facility uses state-of-the-art technology to bring the Temple Mount to life. This will give us a better understanding of the magnitude of Herod's construction versus what we see today.

**Burnt house** – Here, we see the excavations of a 1st century wealthy residence which was partially destroyed by the Romans in 70 AD.

**City of David** – We will be guided through the site and new excavations of the city of David in Jerusalem. You will have the opportunity to walk through Hezekiah's tunnel and will re-surface at the pool of Siloam.

**Old City** – Here we will walk through the streets of the Armenian and Jewish quarters of old Jerusalem.

Dinner will be back at our hotel. (B, D)

#### DAY 15 – THURSDAY, OCTOBER 31: BETHLEHEM, GARDEN TOMB

**Bethlehem** - A visit to the outskirts of Jerusalem and the city of bread, 'Bethlehem,' where we shall visit: Manger Square, Church of the Nativity, Shepherd's Fields. From Bethlehem, we shall return to Jerusalem and finish our journey with a truly memorable visit to the Garden Tomb. Here we shall have a private worship service with communion, before returning to our hotel.

**Garden Tomb** – Preserved by The Garden Tomb Association these beautiful gardens surround the traditional site of The Garden Tomb. Many believe that this was the actual garden of Joseph of Arimathea. (John 19:41)

This evening we will enjoy our last dinner together in Jerusalem. A wonderful time to share & reflect on what this journey has meant to you! (B, D)

#### DAY 16 – FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 1: DEPART ISRAEL FOR CANADA

After a memorable journey, we depart for our flights back to Canada. In-flight service will be provided onboard. (B, D)
